### Rocking Horse Farm 2nd & 3rd Addition Exterior Design and Review Application

So now you've chosen Rocking Horse Farm for your new home! And you're excited to get going, but you also have a lot of decisions to make. That's why we've set up the exterior design and review process to move quickly so your builder can start building and you can start making memories in your new home as soon as possible. Here's how it will work:

## Step 1

#### Start With a Home Plan

Once you've selected your lot and builder, you'll work with them to select a home floor plan. It may be a model that your builder offers or a custom design.

As soon as you have an idea of what you'd like the exterior of your home to look like, your builder will get in touch with us. He or she will share with us any floor plans and "inspiration"



images you have (pictures from magazines, drawings ... anything, really) for how you'd like your new home to look, and let us know preferences for things like roof pitch, materials and brands (this will help us make sure we come back with exterior design suggestions that fit your budget). Even if you're working with your own architect or designer, this is still a good time for all of us to touch base – we'll make sure everyone is on the same page.

#### > Translating Your Vision

# Step 3 (5 business days)



### > Design Review

Once you and your builder have incorporated elements of the complimentary exterior design illustration into your home, your builder will submit finished building plans to the Rocking Horse Farm Architectural Review Committee. Since we already worked with you in Step 2, our goal is to make this a formality.

We'll take a look and get back within five working days. At this point, we may either approve with no changes or offer comments and suggested design notes. If we approve with no changes, you're ready to go.
